

2023 Legend Trail Ladies Club Club Championship

Mon, April 17th & Weds, April 19th

FORMAT:

This is a two-day stroke play tournament with gross and net winners. Players will be divided into 2 or more flights, depending on the number of participants. A minimum of 16 players is recommended for the tournament.

The player with the lowest 2-day gross score is the **Club Champion**, and the player with the lowest 2-day net score is the **Club Champion Low Net** winner. Participants in all flights will compete for low gross and low net winner. There will be 2nd place low gross and low net winners. A player can win only one award, for example the Club Champion Low Net winner cannot also be the low net flight winner.

If two days of play cannot be completed, the championship will be called after a minimum of 18 holes have been played. If more than 18 holes have been played, those scores will be taken into account contingent on all respective players completing the same amount of additional holes. If the minimum amount of holes cannot be completed, the Club Championship will be canceled.

On Weds., April 19th, all Club Championship participants may play in the weekly game as well.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

USGA Rules and league adopted local rules will apply. This includes “Desert Rule” and “Lift, Rake & Replace” in the bunkers when your ball is lying in a footprint. The local rules also include the use of “Drop Zones” on Hole 7 & 13. Plus we will use the newly adopted local rule pertaining to the manmade sandy wall in the wash on Hole 17, find nearest complete relief and from that point, drop your ball – within one club length no closer to the hole.

The area to the right of the cart path on hole #17 inside the white stakes near the condominiums is **not out of bounds**. You may play your ball from that area.

Trade scorecards with one of your playing partners. After the round, sign your scorecard and have it attested. Turn your scorecard into the appointed “scorer” in the Cantina. Mary Ellen Nichols will post your scores. All scores will be entered as competition scores.

Breaking Ties

Low Gross: Best back 9 on player’s last day of play; if still tied, last 6 holes; if still tied, last 3 holes; if still tied, the 18th hole.

Low Net: Best back 9 on player’s last day of play minus one-half handicap, if still tied; last 6 holes minus one-third of handicap; if still tied, last 3 holes minus one-sixth of handicap. Fractions should not be disregarded. Stroke fractions of one-half stroke or more should count as a full stroke and any lesser fraction will be disregarded.
