Club Championship

- Phrasing on prize for championship; It was decided that the Low Gross Champion (or Club Champion) could come from any flight so award should not indicate a flight.
- There was a discussion of capping max scores on individual holes for pace of play. After reviewing hole-by-hole scores, it was voted **not** to cap at this time.
- Budget for championship was reviewed, total spent was just under budgeted amount.

2022/2023 Season Opener

- The board will continue to plan the season opener rather than Event Coordinator and committee due to proximity of league members.
- Theme for opener was discussed
- Discussion of an early shotgun to allow all players to come in at once for lunch and opening meeting.
- Possibility of offering bag tags (similar to prizes from club championship) at the cost of the member was considered as an option with sign-up information.
- Season opener will be delayed one week (along with entire league calendar) to coordinate with over-see and cart path dates. Tentative date: Wednesday, November 2.

Year-End Event

- Committee finalizing decorations, food, ABCD teams, and other details for event.
- Budget and prize money for winning teams, and on-course events was reviewed

Treasurer's Report

- Current to final budget review – budget is balanced to date, no over expenditures

Membership Report

- Medical waivers reviewed

Miscellaneous

- The board unanimously voted to eliminate the birdie tree for next year
- Local rule adopted on 12/15/20 for hole #13 was reviewed. Board vote to keep as is except when play does not warrant local rules.
