September 22nd – Board Meeting – Closed on Zoom

November 2nd – "Season Opener" ABCD pairing

November 9th – "Blind 9" Individual event Random pairing

Nine holes will be randomly chosen by the pro-shop to count for the game. **Total All gross scores** and **total ALL net scores on the holes listed. You will have 9 net scores.**

November 15th – Board Meeting 3 pm Cantina

November 16th - "Chapman Scotch" 2-person event AD/BC pairing

Both tee off, hit your partners drive then choose one ball and alternate from there until it's in the hole. This score cannot be posted. **Total All gross scores** and **total ALL net scores. You will have 18 net scores.**

November 23rd – "Toes" Individual event ABCD pairing

Holes that start with T, O, E, S will count (1,2,3,6,7,8,10,11,12,13,16,17,18). Total All gross scores and total ALL net scores on the holes listed. You will have 10 net scores.

November 30th – "Three Blind Mice" Individual event AB/CD pairing

Before teeing off pick 3 holes to throw out. This is a net game on holes you picked to keep. **Total ALL gross score** and total **ALL net scores minus 3 holes you throw out. You will have 15 net scores.**

December 7th – "Partners in Crime" 2-person event AD/BC pairing

You and your cart partner pick the best net ball on each hole. This is a net score game. **Total ALL gross and ALL net scores.**

December 13th – Board Meeting 3 pm Cantina

December 14th – "Bookends" Individual event Random pairing

Holes 1-5 and 14-18 will count. This is a net score game on holes listed. Total All gross scores and total ALL net scores on the holes listed. You will have 10 net scores.

December 21st – "Sweet 16" Individual event random pairing

After play you may throw out one score on the front and one on the back. This is a net score game on holes you keep. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores minus the 2 scores thrown out. You will have 16 net scores.

December 28th – "Better side" Individual event AB/CD pairing

After play choose the best total front nine or back nine net score. This is a net score game on the holes you pick. **Total ALL gross scores** and **total ALL net scores on side you keep. You will have 9 net scores.**

January 4th – "State Medallion 1st round" "Fabulous Fours" individual event Like handicap low to high pairing The par 4's are the only holes that count. State Medallion players may also play in the game. This is a net score game on the par 4's only. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores on the par 4's only. You will have 10 net scores.

January 10th – Board Meeting 3 pm Cantina

January 11th – "One's" individual event AB/CD pairing

Only holes that start with O, N, E, S count (1,6,7,8,9,11,16,17,18). This is a net score game on holes listed. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores on holes listed. You will have 9 holes net scores.

January 18th – "Criss Cross" individual event AD/BC pairing

Choose 1 or 10, 2 or 11, 3 or 12 etc. after play. Nine holes will be your total score. This is a net score game. **Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores you keep according to instructions.** You will have 9 scores for net.

January 25th - "Mid-Season Event Ryder Cup" ABCD pairing

February 1st – **"State Medallion 2**nd **round" "Low Gross Low Net" individual event like handicap high to low.** This is a low gross and low net game. **Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores.**

February 7th – Board Meeting 3 pm Cantina

February 8th – "3 Clubs & a Putter" This will be a 9-hole individual event in the afternoon AB/CD pairing You may use only 3 clubs and your putter to play all 9 holes. Choose the 3 clubs before you start play. This is a net game with 2 net winners & 4 Proxies, paid out same day. Total your 9 gross & net scores. Your score will not be recorded with USGA/GHIN.

February 15th – "Match Play 1st round" "Even and Odds" individual event like handicap low to high Even holes on the front and odd holes on the back will be only holes to count. Match players may not play in the weekly game. This is a net game. Total ALL gross scores and ALL net scores. You will have 8 net scores.

February 22nd – League Cancelled due to weather

March 1st – "Match Play 2nd round" "Criers" individual event AB/CD pairing

After play convert 3 worst holes to net par. Match players may not play in the weekly game. This is a net game. **Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores according to instructions. You will have 18 net scores.**

March 7th – Board meeting 3 pm Cantina

March 8th – "Match Play final round" "Easy Nine" individual event like handicap high to low The highest 9 handicapped holes will be only ones counted (2,5,6,9,10,12,14,15,18). Match players may not play in the weekly game. This is a net game. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores listed. You will have 9 net scores.

March 15th – "22" 2-person event AD/BC pairing

While playing determine if you will keep 0, 1 or 2 net scores before play on next hole. You must have 22 scores at the end of the round. Score will be relative to par. Net bogey is +1, par is 0, net birdies are -1, net eagles are -2 etc. your score will be +/- to par including scores kept on each hole. This is a net game. Total ALL gross and keep your net score +/- according to par. You will have 22 net scores combined between 2 players.

March 22nd –"State medallion 3rd round" "Consecutive three" individual event Random pairing

After play you will eliminate any 3 consecutive holes. This is a net game. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores minus the 3 consecutive holes you eliminate. You will have 15 net scores.

March 29th - "Hard Nine" individual event Random pairing

The hardest handicapped holes will count (1,3,4,7,9,11,13,16,17). This is a net game. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores according to instructions. You will have 9 net scores.

The odd holes on the front and even holes on the back are only holes that will count. State Medallion players may play game. This is a net game. Total ALL gross scores and total all net scores according to instructions. You will have 10 net scores.

April 11th – Board Meeting 3pm Cantina

April 12th – "Stapleford" 4-person event ABCD pairing

Points will 1 for net bogey, 2 for net par, 3 for net birdie, 4 for net eagle, and 5 for net albatross. Total points should be all players points recorded on card. This is a net game. **Total All gross scores and total ALL points as per instructions.**

April 17th – "Monday Club Championship first round" like handicap high to low pairing

This is low gross and low net game. Total ALL gross scores and total ALL net scores. You will have 18 gross scores and 18 net scores.

April 19th – "Club Championship final round" individual event Low gross low net. Like handicap high to low. This is a low gross and low net game. Players in club championship may play game. Total ALL gross scores and total all net scores. You will have 18 gross scores and 18 net scores.
