Match Play Update

- Ann Gray, Kelly Carter and Tura Resavage heading up the committee
- Details, dates and timeline for planning were reviewed
- Entry fee to be \$40 for a two-person team
- Unanimously approved by board vote: matches will count toward a player's annual minimum times of play no matter what day of the week play occurs since this is a league event

Miscellaneous Items Discussed

- It was suggested by league member Trudy Clifft to offer waitlisters a 'partial' or 'temporary' membership for the months of November and December because of low participation by the membership. Details were not finalized but, the discussion was to charge them a lesser membership fee, add them to the sign-up method for those months (LTGALZ at this time), and allow them to participate in the game. The board agreed that this would be a great way to introduce them to the league and to help fill the tee times provided by the pro shop.
- Possibility of amending the league by-laws to allow for earlier election of officers and the possibility of adding 2 more board members was discussed. Due to the growing league and the nature of a smooth changeover of board members, the current board thought this would be a good option. To change the by-laws, a positive vote by at least 2/3 of the membership is required. Cindy is going to work on verbiage and method to move forward with this.

Mid-Season Event

- The mid-season Ryder Cup event planning is almost complete, and the committee is ready for 'The Cactus Cup'. There will be closest to the pin events, men's club champion driving on a hole, and some fun after at the Cantina.
- The league did secure one extra tee time for this event allowing 52 golfers
- Currently everything is on budget for this event
